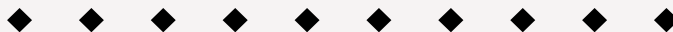

Judy was a long standing member of the Manitoba Home and School Parent Teacher Federation (MHSPTF) and Manitoba Association of Parent Councils (MAPC). She served in various executive positions including President of MHSPTF and Western Vice President of the Canadian Home and School Federation. Judy continued to contribute to MAPC activities after retiring from the Board of Directors. She was always willing to help at the Annual General Meetings as Parliamentarian and provide sound advice and knowledge about the history surrounding parent associations in Manitoba.

The Judy Aiken Memorial Award

The Judy Aiken Memorial Award is presented annually to an individual who demonstrates the spirit of volunteerism by making a significant contribution to schools in Manitoba.

Who Can Be Nominated?

Each eligible nominee must be a school volunteer who:

- Has served with a school parent advisory group for a minimum of six years combined between school communities
- Has contributed in numerous capacities in the best interest of the students
- Has played an instrumental role in promoting parental involvement in the school

And has demonstrated:

- Energy and enthusiasm for their volunteer duties
- Cooperation and teamwork
- Dedication and commitment to completing tasks

Nomination

Any *member group in good standing* of Manitoba Association of Parent Councils can nominate a *volunteer from their school community* for this award.

To nominate an individual for the Judy Aiken Award, you must:

- Verify your membership status with Manitoba Association of Parent Councils.
- Complete the enclosed nomination form and confirm that all information requested is included. *Did you speak to all partners in your school community about this individual to enhance your submission?*
